#### **Celebrating Our Faculty**

As part of our commitment to exceptional dance education, we'd like to take a moment to celebrate each member of our faculty. These are just a few highlights. There's so much more each brings, day in and day out to our studio.

- Elaine Seidman (Artistic Director): Elaine holds the prestigious Maestro Enrico Cecchetti Diploma and has been awarded a Sylvia Hamer / Margaret Marsh Scholarship to study the Cecchetti method in England.
- Diane Robertson (Business Director): Diane bridges art and science—she holds a B.S. in Physical Therapy and a Master of Health Science and works clinically, bringing a deep understanding of movement and anatomy to the studio's operations.
- **CJ Cunningham (Faculty):** CJ runs his own company *Fusion Entertainment* and crew *FloMotion*. His constant high energy and intricate choreography demands everyones attention, dancers and audience member alike.
- Blair D'Amico (Faculty): Blair trained at KS Dance Ltd in England, where she earned a Trinity College National Diploma in Professional Dance, won the Best All Round Dancer Award, and toured with the company from corps to principal roles. She is also certified to teach every level from 1-10 of the Cecchetti Method.
- Linda Grimm (Faculty): Linda has been teaching since 2008, is certified in the Cecchetti Method, and continues to deepen her own training under Elaine's mentorship.
- Stephaen Hood (Faculty): Stephaen earned a BFA in Classical Ballet, danced with Verb Ballets for three seasons, and has been a soloist with Ballet Theatre of Maryland.
- Maggie Lockhart (Faculty): A versatile educator with a professional performance career in NYC and DC, she holds Cecchetti certificates through the Professional Advanced level and received Horton Technique teacher training from Alvin Ailey American Dance Theatre.
- Wyndee McGovern (Faculty): Wyndee founded the pre-professional company *Jazzfuzion*, whose works made a Broadway debut at the St. James Theater in New York. She is the founder of The McGovern Method.
- Sydney Pearson (Faculty): Sydney holds a BA in Dance and recently earned her Maryland State Teaching Certification in K–12 Dance Education.
- Alina Sage (Faculty): Alina has performed full-length ballets including *The Nutcracker, Coppelia, and Sleeping Beauty* while also rigorous training in both Vaganova and Cecchetti methods.
- Rose Seidman (Faculty): Rose is an eight-time competition title winner, graduated *cum laude* with a BFA in dance from Adelphi University, and has performed in film, television, commercial work, and on Broadway-adjacent projects.

#### Who Participates in the Ballet Production?

**Most Cecchetti Ballet technique classes** participate in the Ballet Production. Those classes selected to participate will be notified in the new year. If not selected, the Cecchetti class will participate in the Spring Performance. Rehearsals are held during regular class time. There may be additional rehearsals scheduled in the spring. Families will be notified n a timely manner.

#### Who Participates in the Spring Performance?

Tap, Jazz, Modern, Lyrical, Hip Hop, Combo, Creative Movement, Pre-Cecchetti, and non-syllabus Ballet participate in the Spring Performance. Cecchetti classes not selected to participate in the Ballet Production participate in the Spring Performance. Dance With Me and Stretch/Turns/Leaps classes do not perform.

If your dancer is enrolled in a class that participates in the Spring Performance
AND a Cecchetti class selected to participate in the Ballet Production,
THEY PERFORM IN BOTH.

#### **Participation Fee**

Students performing in **either** the Ballet Production **or** Spring Performances: \$95/student Students performing in **both** the Ballet Production **and** Spring Performances: \$125/student

### Costume Fee Spring Performance

Fee: \$85.00 + tax (per costume)

Fees are added to accounts in December and due with December tuition.

#### **Ballet Production**

Fee: \$100.00/costume (may be less depending on assigned role) Ballet Production costumes are added to accounts in the Spring
